



SPRING SHOOTING YOUTH FEST

SATURDAY APRIL 18, 2009

The Seminole County Gun & Archery Association (SCGAA) invites all young men and women from 9 to 18 years-old, along with youth-oriented civic groups to register for the Youth Fest. This will be a fun-filled day of outdoor shooting, archery, and exhibits. Prior shooting experience is not required.

Events: SCGAA will open several ranges and establish a variety of shooting stations among which youth groups will rotate to shoot smallbore rifles (.22), shotguns (20ga, 12ga), and black powder rifles (.50) at silhouette targets and paper targets from traditional shooting positions. Additionally, our Archery Range will offer various bow & arrow exercises to challenge the participants.

When: Saturday, 18 April 2009 -- Check in will commence at 8:00 AM followed by a range safety briefing. Shooting activities will run from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

Youth Participation & Adult Supervision: This day long shooting opportunity is for all youths between the ages of **9 and 18** years to experience shooting sports in a safe, controlled environment under the supervision of Range Safety Officers and range staff.

- ★ Youth Groups such as Scouts, 4H, YMCA, FFA, etc... are encouraged to participate.
- ★ Groups desiring to camp overnight, (Fri. to Sat.) must make prior arrangements by contacting SCGAA (see contact below); no water, power, or firewood is available. Port-O-Lets are available on-site.
- ★ ALL individual participants and groups **MUST HAVE** sufficient and continuous adult leadership and supervision while on SCGAA property. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- ★ SCGAA reserves the right to terminate individual or group participation at any time; fee refunds will not be made for youths asked to leave due to behavior /safety/rules violations.
- ★ Youths under 9 may not participate

NOTE: THIS IS NOT A SANCTIONED BSA EVENT...as such, it does not meet the requirements for a Merit Badge. Per BSA rules, Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts under 11 cannot shoot firearms as a sanctioned BSA event. Cub Scouts/Boy Scouts under 11 years-old may shoot as if the Youth Fest were family outing (just leave your uniforms home).

Equipment: SCGAA will provide equipment, ammunition, targets, range staff, and safety officers. **Please bring your own eye protection(must be safety glasses) and a long sleeve shirt or jacket. If you have hearing protection bring it.**

PLEASE DO NOT BRING FIREARMS OR AMMO TO THIS EVENT!!!
